

Camel to Breakfast

This fantastic adventure begins at sunrise. Departing from Pichi Richi Camel Farm, you’ll ride through mallee scrubland. As the sky slowly changes from black to deep blue to bright azure, the sun peeking over the lip of the Horseshoe Range before lighting up the Willochra Plain. You slowly leave Devils Peak behind you.

An easy descent from the ridge will find you in the Pichi Richi Valley. This valley is bordered on one side by the ridge you have just ridden down and to the other the towering red cliffs of the Dutchman Escarpment, glowing orange in the rising sunlight. A small and usually dry creek bed meanders through this valley, dotted by ancient River Red Gums.

Loads of kangaroo’s and wallabies nibble on the grass, sometimes even an emu or two casually stroll past.

An hour after beginning your ride you will arrive at an open air b-b-q setting, in the middle of the bush land. As your guide lights the fire, sets the billy to boil & fires up the barbie, the galahs and corellas begin their morning calls.

Breakfast is a choice of cooked or continental – or both if you’ve worked up a good appetite. There’s plenty of time to relax by the fire, morning coffee or billy tea in hand, and absorb the sounds of the bush. A pleasant stroll will take you back to Pichi Richi Camel Farm HQ and the conclusion of your breakfast tour.
