

Two Day Safari Itinerary

Safari.

If you can't get to us yourself please check out our Gold and Silver packages further down the page, they all leave from Adelaide.

Saturday: Your camel adventure begins at 10:30am. After a safety briefing your gear is loaded into a 4WD and you will be transferred to the Argadell's Range, a magnificent range, filled with gum lined gorges, 30km north of Quorn. This is also home to the endangered Yellow-footed Rock-wallaby. After being introduced to your camel it's "all aboard" for the first leg of your safari. This will take you through Hannahman Gorge, with it's (almost) permanent water supply; you'll see Kookaburra's fishing in the waterholes and plenty of kangaroo's and wallabies. Your arrival in a native pine glen signals lunch. Leisurely meal breaks are filled with the opportunity to explore on foot.

After lunch you'll wile away the afternoon ride watching emus feeding on the spinifex filled plateau's, wedge tailed eagles lazily cruising the thermals above and the views from the high points are unbelievable; ridge after ridge of ranges, all the way to the distant walls of Wilpena Pound.

You'll arrive at your camp, in the heart of the native bush, in the late afternoon, perfect light to photograph the surrounding ranges and perfect timing as this is when the wildlife becomes most active.

Explore on foot whilst the first course of your three course evening meal is prepared. Try not to drool as you await such entrées as a Yabbie Cocktail or Wattle Seed Chicken Strips, main course could be a Desert Herb Encrusted Steak served with Bush Tomato Chutney or perhaps Lemon Myrtle Baked Barramundi, washed down with an ice cold beer or Australian wine. Relax around the fire while your dessert is prepared; Quandong Pie or maybe Muntrie Brulee.

Watch the flames flickering in the fire as the evening turns to night and the first stars wink on, before retiring to your swag for a comfortable night's sleep.

Sunday: If you're feeling energetic you can climb the ridge behind your camp and watch the sun rise. If you're not feeling that inspired then take the opportunity to snuggle into the warmth of your swag.

Breakfast comes with a choice of cooked or continental. Then climb aboard your camel ready for your morning ride, beneath the inspiring Mt Arden, across high plateau's, today's views will have you gazing in awe at the blue waters of the Spencer Gulf to the south whilst to the north-west lays the vast salt expanse of Lake Torrens, over 200km long & 20km wide.

Watch the wild goats hop from ledge to ledge while you wait for the Billy to boil. After morning tea your riding track will gradually descend until you find yourself at the mouth of South Gorge. Again a leisurely lunch break gives you plenty of time to go in search of those elusive Yellow-footed Rock-wallabies who have made this gorge their home.

A short afternoon ride will complete your camel safari adventure at around 2:30pm, and a vehicle transfer will have you back at Pichi Richi Camel Farm at approximately 3:00pm, ready for your next adventure!

Ex-Adelaide; Choose from Gold or Silver packages.

Gold:

Friday: This tour departs from Adelaide airport at 5:15pm. Fly with Sharp Airlines from Adelaide to Port Augusta, arriving at approximately 6:05pm. You will be met & transferred to your accommodation, a quaint B&B in Quorn still with time to freshen up before your evening meal.

Saturday: Cooked breakfast provisions are included, take your time over breakfast before being collected at 10:00am and transferred to Pichi Richi Camel Farm for the beginning of your camel adventure, see above.

Sunday: At the end of your camel adventure you will be collected by your guide for your return journey, via Pichi Richi Pass, into Pt Augustayou're your return flight to Adelaide, departing at 4:05pm and arriving in Adelaide at approximately 4:55pm.

Silver:

Friday: Make your own way to the Adelaide Central Bus Station, 111 Franklin Street Adelaide. Your coach will depart at 11:00am. A four hour coach ride along the edge of the Spencer Gulf will bring you into Port Augusta. You will be greeted and transferred to the township of Quorn and your self contained cabin accommodation for the night.

Tonight's meal is not included in this package, however with four pubs, a restaurant, numerous cafes and a general store all within walking distance you will not have any trouble finding something to suit any taste.

Saturday: After doing your own thing for breakfast you will be collected from your cabin at 10:00am and transferred to Pichi Richi Camel Farm ready to begin your camel adventure, see above.

Sunday: Cost of package includes return transfer to Port Augusta at the conclusion of your safari, and a return coach ticket to Adelaide, departing at 5:05pm. (Arriving in Adelaide at 9:10pm)

Please note that for all packages you can delay your return journey, stay longer and explore further.

Minimum four persons for all safari departures or single supplement prices can be arranged on application.
